

# (Call for Applications) 2026 SNUE Summer Korean Language and Culture Program

♠ Seoul National University of Education (SNUE) has organized a Korean culture experience program for students from SNUE's partner universities. Hosted by the Center of International Affairs of SNUE, this program provides participants with opportunities to experience various aspects of Korean culture together with students from partner universities, thereby enhancing their understanding of Korean culture. We encourage interested students to apply.

## □ Program Overview

1. **Program Period:** August 10 (Monday) - August 14 (Friday), 2026(5 days, 4 nights)

2. **Number of Participants:** Up to **4 students** from each university

3. **Main Program Activities** ※ *The schedule is subject to change.*

- **(Introduction)** Orientation and campus tour
- **(Classes)** K-pop dance, Korean Cooking Class, calligraphy
- **(Cultural Experiences)** Visit to Gyeongbokgung Palace (including Hanbok experience), Bukchon Hanok Village, and the War Memorial of Korea
- **(Others)** Free time for sightseeing at major attractions

4. **Participation Fee:** **KRW 300,000 (per student)**

※ *To be collected by each university and remitted to SNUE in Korean won*

- **(Included)** in the Fee
  - Program costs (classes, tour, and activity fees)
  - Airport pick-up and drop-off service (arrival and departure days)
  - Four lunches during the program
- **(Not Included)** Participants Must Arrange Individually
  - **Accommodation, Round-trip airfare**, Overseas travel insurance, Breakfast and dinner during the program, Local transportation expenses
  - Any other expenses related to participation in the program

### ※ 【 Important Notes 】

- ▶ The 2026 program will be operated on a participant-paid basis. Except for the costs of classes, activities, and lunches, all other expenses will not be covered and must be paid by participants. Please take this into consideration before applying.
- ▶ Accommodation is not provided. Participants are advised to book a nearby hotel individually.
- ▶ Participants should purchase their own round-trip airfare from the nearest airport to **Incheon International Airport** according to the designated meeting time(The meeting time and location at Incheon International Airport will be announced later)
- ▶ Shuttle buses for airport pick-up and drop-off will each be provided **once**. Students are encouraged to coordinate their flights and arrive at/depart from Incheon International Airport as a group.

※ The program may be canceled if the minimum number of participants required for operation is not met.

## 5. Safety Management

- Participants are expected to actively cooperate with safety guidance provided by faculty and staff members.

## 6. Application Procedures

- Each university will recruit and select participants through its International Exchange Center.
- Participation fees must be collected by each university and transferred in Korean Won **by July 10, 2026 (Friday)** (\*Payment account information will be provided separately)

※ *Payments are non-refundable once made. A participant may be replaced by another student only if the replacement does not affect the smooth operation of the experience program.*

- Each university should submit **the application forms and passport copies** to the International Exchange Center of SNUE via email (**e-mail: cice@snue.ac.kr**)

## 7. Notes

- No academic credits from SNUE will be awarded for participation in this program.
- Participants are required to join a LINE group for communication before and during the program, as well as for safety purposes.
- All participants must obtain overseas **travel insurance** individually and carry proof of insurance while traveling.
- Participants are requested to complete a post-program evaluation and feedback survey.
